Our mentoring programs are for any middle or high school youth who lives or goes to school in Aurora. Join one of our programs to reach your full potential, make friends, and have fun!



### **One-to-One Community-Based Mentoring**

AYO matches middle and high school students with adult mentors based on personality, interests, and experience. Youth meet up with their mentors twice a month in the community doing activities they enjoy.

### **Group Mentoring**

AYO has a homework help program every Wednesday from 4-6pm for any youth. In January, AYO will start group mentoring twice a month at AYO offices. We also have ongoing field trip opportunities and summer programming when school is not in session. These are fun ways to interact with other youth and AYO staff, doing prosocial activities and growing together.
