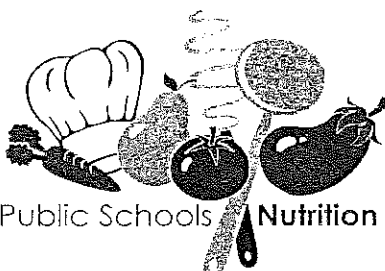

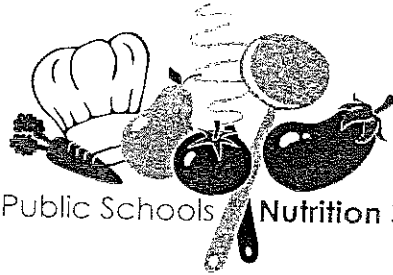

Planting for Pollinators

Saturday, June 10, 9:30 - 11:30 am

Assist Refuge staff by enhancing habitat for pollinators by planting native wildflowers along the Lake Ladora trail. These plants provide an ongoing nectar source for butterflies, bees, and other pollinators. Be ready to work outdoors for 1-1.5 hours, wear closed toe shoes, bring water, and sunscreen.

Nature Tots Magnificent Monarchs!

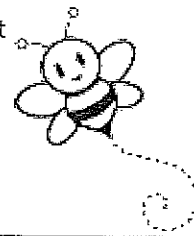
Thursday June 22, 10:00 - 11:00 am
